7th CEQURA Conference on

The 7th CEQURA Conference on Advances in Financial and Insurance Risk Management, organized by the Society for Financial and Insurance Econometrics and in collaboration with the Montreal Institute of Structured Products and Derivatives and the Bayerisches Finanz Zentrum, provides a platform for presenting and discussing current developments in research and industry, and fosters the exchange between academics and practitioners from the risk management community.

Both academics and practitioners are encouraged to participate. To present theoretical or applied research work, please submit an abstract (200–400 words) by June 10, 2016.

Submissions in all areas of financial and insurance risk management are welcome. A particular focus of this year's conference will be *Digitalization in Finance and Insurance* as well as *Data Science in Finance and Insurance*. General topics of interest include but are not limited to:

- Market, credit, operational, liquidity, and energy risk
- Stress testing and scenario analysis
- Systemic risk in banking and insurance
- Solvency II and Basel III
- Dependence modeling
- Risk dynamics
- Real- and financial-sector interactions

Special journal issue: Presenters will have the opportunity, but are not required to submit their work to a special issue of the *Journal of Risk and Financial Management* on "Advances in Financial and Insurance Risk Management."
